## 1. OBJECTIVE

The "Industra Bank" Cookie Policy is developed to provide additional information to visitors of the Bank's website about the technologies used on the site and how the Bank utilizes them to achieve the following objectives:

- Maintain a high level of Cookie processing quality and ensure data protection in accordance with legal requirements;
- Preserve and enhance the trust of existing and potential Clients in the Bank;
- Ensure transparent and understandable cookie processing processes;
- Mitigate the risk of unauthorized cookie processing, regulate the Bank's actions in cases of data protection breaches.

## 2. TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

## 3. GENERAL RULES

- 3.1. Joint-stock company "Industra Bank", registration No. 5948493838, address: Muitas iela 1, Riga, LV-1010; email address: info@industra.finance; website address <a href="https://www.industra.finance/">https://www.industra.finance/</a> (hereinafter the Bank) undertakes to ensure the security of the Bank's website <a href="https://www.industra.finance/">https://www.industra.finance/</a> (hereinafter the website) and the personal information of its visitors and to protect their rights when visiting the Bank's website and reviewing its content.
- 3.2. The Policy is developed considering the requirements of the Regulation aimed at ensuring the security of Personal Data and the protection of Individual's rights. The Bank processes personal data of individuals, respecting their interests to protect their privacy.
- 3.3. The Policy sets out the basic principles of Cookie processing at the Bank.

#### 4. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF COOKIES CREATION

- 4.1. Cookies are necessary for the website visitor to use the Bank's digital services more conveniently, such as making online payments, for the Bank to obtain information on how visitors use the Bank's website, and for the Bank to improve the services offered to visitors. Cookies are also used to provide website visitors with tailored information about the Bank's products and services.
- 4.2. The Bank uses various types of cookies, which are placed by default (<u>Essential Cookies</u>), but for certain cookies used for analytical (<u>Analytical Cookies</u>) and audience selection purposes (<u>Marketing Cookies</u>), the Bank requires the website visitor's consent. By giving consent in the cookie banner displayed when visiting the website, the website visitor chooses whether to allow the use of certain cookie categories.

#### 5. TYPES OF COOKIES AND THEIR USE

5.1. The Bank uses three categories of cookies, but requires user consent for only two of them. The website visitor may consent to both cookie categories or only one of them. By consenting to a cookie category, the website visitor grants consent to all

- cookies included in that category (see Clauses 5.2.-5.4. of the Policy). The website visitor may change their choices at any time and opt-out of cookies.
- 5.2. Essential Cookies. Essential cookies are essential and allow the website visitor to access various parts of the website. These cookies are stored on the website visitor's computer, smartphone, tablet, or other device during the website visit or for a specific period of time. They are set in response to the website visitor's actions, which are considered as requesting a service, such as setting privacy preferences, logging in, or filling out a form. These cookies are necessary for the website to function, so they cannot be disabled, and therefore, the user's consent to this category of cookies is not required.
- 5.3. <u>Analytical Cookies</u>. Analytical cookies allow tracking the number and sources of visits to enable the Bank to measure and improve the performance of its website. They help the Bank understand which pages are the most popular and which are used the least, as well as how visitors navigate the Bank's website. If a website visitor refuses to use these cookies, their visit will not be included in the Bank's statistics, but it will not limit the website visitor's activities on the Bank's website.
- 5.4. Marketing Cookies. Marketing cookies are used to identify desired content for website visitors on this website and provide them with the most appropriate information about the Bank's products and services, improve the customization of Bank content, and expand website visitors' activities on the Bank's website. These cookies may be used for the Bank's advertising campaigns on third-party websites. If a website visitor agrees to the use of these cookies, the Bank may also receive information about trusted partner websites of the Bank, where the website visitor has responded to the Bank's advertisements. If a website visitor refuses to use these cookies, they will be offered general and non-personalized advertisements.

#### 6. LIST OF COOKIES USED ON THE WEBSITE

<u>Essential Cookies</u> - these cookies ensure the correct operation of the website, providing its basic functions. The website will not function properly without these cookies.

# 7. INFORMATION ABOUT THE CONSENT GIVEN FOR COOKIE CREATION

- 7.1. When visiting this website, the user is presented with a message stating that cookies are being used on the site. If the website user clicks on the "ACCEPT" option, it means that they have agreed to all cookies present on the website and confirm that they have read the information about cookies, their purposes, and cases when information is shared with third parties.
- 7.2. Regarding "necessary" cookies, user consent is not required because these cookies ensure the complete and uninterrupted display of content on the <a href="https://www.industra.finance/">https://www.industra.finance/</a> website, allowing the site user to log in and receive an appropriate digital browsing and online experience.

## 8. COOKIE REJECTION

8.1. If the website visitor wishes to prevent cookies from being used on their device, they can manage cookie preferences by selecting the appropriate option on the website and indicating "DISAGREE". It should be noted that such changes/choices may affect the functionality of the website, potentially limiting the ability of the website visitor to receive personalized offers or advertisements.

## 9. CONSENT WITHDRAWAL

- 9.1. At any time, the website visitor can change which cookies the Bank is allowed to use or opt out of cookie usage altogether. The visitor can opt out of all cookies except for the "necessary" ones.
- 9.2. If the website visitor wishes to give consent or withdraw their consent for analytical and marketing cookies, they should go to the "Bank" section of the Bank's website, then navigate to the "Cookie Policy" under "Bank Policies". There, they should select "change cookie settings" and click on the respective buttons: "I DO NOT AGREE to the use of cookies that collect information not essential for the full functionality of the website" or "I AGREE to the use of all cookies".

# 10. POLICY CHANGES

- 10.1. If the website visitor has questions about personal data processing, we invite them to review the Bank's Personal Data Processing and Protection Policy, which can be found in the "Bank" section of the Bank's website under "Bank Policies" "Personal Data Processing and Protection Policy" or contact the Bank's data protection specialist at dpo@industra.finance.
